Dr. Card grew up in Saskatoon and finished her undergraduate education in Biology at the University of Saskatchewan. She went on to complete both a Doctorate of Veterinary Medicine and Medical Doctorate at the University of Saskatchewan. She finished her residency program in plastic surgery at McMaster University in Hamilton, Ontario. After residency she undertook sub-specialty training in three diverse areas; a fellowship in Microsurgery Research at MD Anderson Cancer Center in Houston, Texas, a Burn fellowship in Auckland, New Zealand at the National Burn Centre, and an intensive Clinical Microsurgery Reconstruction of Breast, Lower limb, and Head & Neck at the University of Manitoba. She is fully certified as a specialist in plastic surgery and is a fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons of Canada.

Dr. Card is eager to bring her expertise in reconstructive and aesthetic plastic surgery to the Saskatoon Health Region. Her main clinical interests include complex microsurgical reconstruction, breast cancer reconstruction, pediatric cleft and hand surgery, complex wound management, breast asymmetry and aesthetics, skin cancer, and body contouring. She volunteers abroad on burn and pediatric cleft missions.
